Falcon School District 49

ESA worked with Falcon to develop an "Energy Team" to help the District improve its facilities and reduce its resource consumption. Some of the Energy Teams accomplishments were:

- Reduced District utilities by \$250,000 annually
- ◆ Published the Falcon and LEED *Technical Guide for New and Remodeled Buildings*
- ♦ Managed a District-wide building automation and lighting retrofit
- Secured a wind-study grant to help the District pursue the installation of an on-site wind turbine

Boulder Valley Schools

ESA served as the District's Project Managers for a \$12.5 million energy retrofit project addressing approximately 50 buildings. The project savings exceeded \$2.5 million per year. The project earned the *Association of Energy Engineers*' Energy Project of the Year Award.

Town of Vail
